Huron Undercover Narcotics Team

The Huron Undercover Narcotics Team (HUNT) is a multi-jurisdictional drug task force that operates in the counties of Alcona, Alpena, Montmorency and Presque Isle. The unit is made up of officers from the Michigan State Police, the Alpena City Police Department, the Alpena County Sheriff's Department, and the Montmorency County Sheriff's Department. HUNT was formed in 1990 and continues to operate with partial funding by a federal grant. State and local contributions make up the remainder of the unit operating costs.

1995 was once again a year of transition for the Huron Undercover Narcotics Team. A shortage of personnel, due to several reasons, caused the team to operate at nearly half strength for most of the year. This manpower shortage, combined with some very lengthy and time consuming investigations, severely limited the capacity of the team.

Despite these obstacles, the tireless dedication of the assigned officers enabled the Huron Undercover Narcotics Team to produce results comparable to, and in some cases, exceed the results of previous years reporting figures. On the following pages you will see this years statistics compared to those generated in previous years. You will note that the team conducted *more* investigations this year than last, but because of the nature of some of those investigations, the team showed a slight decrease in arrests.

The number of searches conducted by HUNT, both search warrants and "knock and talks", remained fairly constant, as did the number of intelligence reports generated by the unit.

The following pages will show that continued commitment to the Huron Undercover Narcotics Team by the communities we serve is a necessity, and more realistically, future enhancement of the unit should be a community goal.
